How to plan a GO! Trip:

1. Brainstorm with your group an activity you would like to pursue as a clinic, day, or weekend trip.
2. Submit to Outdoor Adventures a GO! Request form
3. Outdoor Adventures will put together a trip itinerary and budget
4. Decide and commit to the trip with Outdoor Adventures
5. Your participants sign up individually through the Outdoor Adventures office for your program

Types of programs

1. Weekend trips – We can provide you with an all inclusive weekend trip that leaves Friday at the time your group determines and returns Sunday evening.
2. Day trips – We can provide you with an all inclusive day trip that leaves Saturday or Sunday morning and returns the same day.
3. Clinics – We can provide staffing and equipment on or off site depending on your needs.

Cost

Trip pricing can take many forms: your group can choose how much or how little you want to provide or be involved in planning including food, transportation, and equipment. When you submit your request you will have the chance to choose these parameters.

Trip prices may include (we can provide all or some of these as determined by you):

- food
- lodging
- transportation
- gas
- group equipment (shelters, stoves, water jugs, harnesses, skis)
- personal equipment (backpack, sleeping bags, pads, head lamps)

Clinics: Clinic fees are based on the number of participants and staff needed. For groups under 25 participants, our rate is \$50/hour with a minimum of one hour, and \$10 per staff/hour. Staff numbers and needs are determined by activity and age of participants. It is an additional \$25/hour for groups larger than 25 participants.
